**EMBARCADERO MUNICIPAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT
BOARD VACANCY**

The Embarcadero Municipal Improvement District (EMID) has a vacancy on the five member board. Per California Government Code 1780, the EMID Board has 60 days to appoint a new director or call for a special election.

Background

EMID was created as an Independent California Special District in 1960. A five member Board of Directors, elected at large for 4 year terms, serves at the pleasure of the District's residents.

Qualifications:

Must be over the age of 18
Must be a registered voter residing in the Embarcadero Municipal Improvement District
Must be a legal citizen of the United States

Appointment Process

Individuals interested in being appointed to the EMID Board of Directors must complete a simple application. Copies of the application may be obtained the following way:

Applications Due Date: No later than 4:00 p.m. November 8, 2017.

The EMID Board of Directors is scheduled to make the appointment at the November 8, 2017 Board of Directors meeting.

Responsibilities and Term:

- Must be over the age of 18
- Must be a registered voter of the District
- Must reside within the boundaries of the Embarcadero Municipal Improvement District
- Must be a legal citizen of the United States

- The appointed Board member will serve until the general election in November, 2018. The appointed Board member may then put his/her name on the November, 2018 general election ballot.

- Serving on the board will require a commitment to attend monthly Board Meetings the second Wednesday of each month (holiday schedules may apply) and Committee Meetings. Other requirements include, but are not limited to, the following:
 - Ethics Training, per CA AB1234
 - Sexual Harassment Training, per CA AB1825
 - Annual Statement of Economic Interests (Form 700) reporting per the California Fair Political Practices Commission
